INTRODUCTION

When people were having to be turned down as members as their knowledge or skill base was not high enough they were left frustrated by the lack of professional training around.

The UKLA are long established and have produced many Locksmiths nationwide as well as having trainees come from abroad to attend our course.

The UKLA training course has the benefit of being an intensive training course meaning that after just one course you are ready to start trading (we do not insist on multiple expensive training courses learning one subject at a time).

NEW CAREER OPPORTUNITY

Locksmithing is a career that can be very rewarding both lucratively and in satisfaction. By looking at the average road in the UK you will have roughly 100 properties each usually with a front door (often with a primary and secondary lock) a back door with a lock as well as window locks, sheds, garages etc. Eventually a lock as with all mechanisms will need replacing they may fail, become out dated or just need replacing with new tenants wishing to make sure there are no other keys in circulation. Keys may become lost or broken. As a locksmith you will be the solution to these issues by fixing, fitting or replacing the locks. You will be able to make the client enjoy the security afforded by their premises. In the case of intrusions to property as in burglary you will often find that not only the home involved will require your services but also adjoining properties and neighbours will also want to "beef up" their security.

Depending on your area charges range from **£50-95 per hour labour + parts and materials**. If you decided to attend an out of normal hours call out (often an emergency) then you will be justified to charge double or treble depending on the circumstances (evenings, weekends or bank holidays demand a higher premium).

After instruction on the use of key cutting machines you will see how easy it is to cut both mortice and cylinder keys. This is an extremely profitable part of the business. Some mortice (like a Chubb) key blanks cost under 30p and you could charge between £5.00 - £12.00. Cylinder (like a Yale) key blanks cost 10p and you can charge between £3.00 - £9.00. Not bad for two minutes work.

Final pricing is of course up to your discretion but we do discuss costing and prices on the course and give example rates that we would expect for our services.

With little overheads (normally just a van, tools, stock and phone) you can see becoming a locksmith is profitable. We have taught students who are now earning over 60k pa.


